<u>Seder</u> – Christians are interested in the Seder because it was during Jesus' last Passover celebration with his disciples, that the Lord's Supper was instituted. However, the Seder is not a Christian event. We participate in this act to remind us of Jesus' roots in Judaism. By the time Jesus participated in this festival it was over 1000 years old. It was, and is, separate from our participation in the Sacrament of

Holy Communion. We will participate in a Seder Supper on April 13 at 6:00 p.m. – freewill offering. We will be serving lamb, roast beef, rice, pasta salad, etc. There is a sign-up sheet at the back of the church for those planning to attend.
