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## Vestry Update May 2017

**The Associate Priest** continues to work with the youth as well as developing a ministry of presence with the Anglican Church Homes residents and developing social activities with others within our parish. The Youth Group will be asked to participate in the Take-Out Lunch project.

**Property Report:** A sensor light has been installed. Thanks to several people, the church yard has had a spring “yard-lift” and Dyers Cemetery and Lawn Care will do the mowing. Roof repairs will be completed during the summer by Vail Brothers. Budgeted Tower repairs have been completed by Pat McMackin, exterior window painting at rectory to be completed this summer, and a company that cleans the stained glass windows will be sought.

**Safe Church officer,** Georgie Keith reported that implementation of the Diocesan requirement has begun. Remaining vestry members and other persons to be identified will be required to provide Police Record Checks to Rev. Tom. Continued work to find windows for all doors of rooms are being sought, fire exit routes for all lower level rooms are now posted. Work on the upper level room is progressing. All events in the church complex must complete an event checklist and sign a Schedule N, an agreement to use the building. Ten persons attended a Safe Church Training session in Hampton.

**The Treasurer** provided an explanation of the financial statements. A request from the Parish of New Bandon for a loan for rectory repairs was made. Diocesan protocol has been completed and New Bandon is completing its paperwork. This is an opportunity for good stewardship of money and inter-parish relations. These monies are not accessible to us. A brief explanation was given regarding Restricted funds VS monies with no restrictions.

**Parish Finances:** Cash flow continues to pose concern. A motion was made and carried to transfer remaining funds from Gibson Account to General Funds to help with May. What to do? Big question to be discussed at the Finance Committee meeting on May 24.
