The Parish of Sussex must complete a Safe Church Questionnaire and return it to the insurance company before the end of May. Two of the deficiencies that you can help complete are training and Police Record Checks. There are several others that I must do.

April 2018 Vestry Highlights

New Ministry – The concept of Messy Church is being considered, perhaps in May. This will be open to all members of the congregation and will be on a week night, having a meal and worshipping together during the supper time period. Watch for further details.

Finance Committee – The Treasurer was asked: how long can the Corporation continue to run in the red? What happens next? That is the question; a serious look at what to do is uppermost in minds of Vestry. At the Annual meeting a deficit budget was passed. Now it is our responsibility as a congregation to work at eliminating this deficit. The 2018 Budget Fund Special envelope, a small brown one, is located in the pews and parishioners are encouraged to use it regularly, coin, paper or cheque. We do not want to be discouraged during this time nor do we want our many ministries to suffer but, the following table shows we are not receiving as much as we are spending.

Crandall Lackie has been awarded the lawn mowing for the church this season.

Shared Ministry - Shared ministry discussions between the Parishes of St. Mark’s and Waterford and Sussex have been put on hold. All parishes wish to continue activities together and share fellowship.
