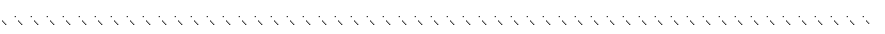

May Vestry Update

Rector's Report – Most activities have concluded until fall. Refreshments and birthday cake will be the first Sunday of June, July and August. Summer service hours begin June 3. Services will be 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. The Rector will be attending Clergy College in Fredericton beginning June 10 for a week following the service. His vacation will be first week of July and August 12 to August 23 or 24.

Wardens' Report – Entryway is to be painted. First pew on the pulpit side of church will be removed and perhaps placed along the back wall of the gym. A quote will be obtained for the installation of a removable handrail for entryway.

Property – Crandall Lackie has been contracted to maintain church lawn this season. Oil deliveries have been stopped until fall. Holes in the alleyway will be filled in. Dishwasher replaced at the rectory. Thank you to the Men's Brotherhood for spring cleaning of the grounds. Motion was passed to rent a mini-split on a three year contract for the office area in order to cut cost of oil heat.

Safe Church – Three training sessions have been held. The Sidespersons schedule will be revamped to have "in church sidespersons" and "counters". In order to comply with Safe Church regulations, a motion was passed to have funeral staff present at all funeral and memorial services.

Financial – The vestry thanks parishioners for the use of the deficit envelopes (brown ones) in addition to their other giving. Church services, needs and expenses continue during the summer. Have you considered switching to e-offering or dropping your tithing envelopes into the church during the summer? Parishioners have responded to our deficit position and thank you. May God continue to bless us as we pray to have our revenue equal or exceed our expenditures in the coming months.
